Let's take a journey in God's Word together over the next 40 days as we prepare for Resurrection (Easter) Sunday. The Gospel of Mark will walk us along the road with Jesus observing Him as Servant and Savior. As we read these daily readings together, I would like to encourage you to go a little deeper and really study these passages. As a staff, we have embarked on a simple study tool that will help you as you read through Mark. It is called the H.E.A.R. Journaling Method. (by Replicate Ministries).

Simply put, the acronym H.E.A.R. stands for Highlight, Explain, Apply, and Respond. You may use whatever Bible translation with which you are most comfortable.

Before reading a passage, pause to sincerely ask God to speak to you. It may not seem like a big deal, but it is extremely important to seek God's guidance in order to understand His Word.

On the back of this booklet, you will find an outline of the H.E.A.R. method that will help you as you journey through Mark! I look forward to seeing what God teaches us as a church body over the next 40 days.

H.E.A.R

HIGHLIGHT the verses that speak to you.

- Write out the name of the book.
- Which chapter and verse numbers stand out to you?
 EXPLAIN what this passage means.
- To whom was it originally written? Why?
- How does it fit with the verses before and after it?
- What is the Holy Spirit intending to communicate through this text?

APPLY what God is saying in these verses to your life.

- What does this mean today?
- What is God saying to you personally?
- How can you apply this message to your life?

RESPOND to what you've read.

- In what ways does this passage call you to action?
- How will you be different because of what you've learned?
- Write out a prayer to God in response to what you read today.
